**What is a Requiem?** Requiem is a Latin word meaning "rest". It is part of the opening words of the Roman Catholic Mass for the Dead, which is spoken or sung in Latin.

**Who is John Rutter?** Born in London in 1945, John Rutter is widely known as a composer and director. His Requiem, set in English and Latin, has become perhaps the most performed requiem of our time, following in the footsteps of the Mozart and Verdi Requiems.

### *Service of Christian Healing*

During both services on February 24, we will take time to pray for and to lay hands on those who need God's healing touch. This service has had a powerful and profound impact on the lives and health of those who attend.
