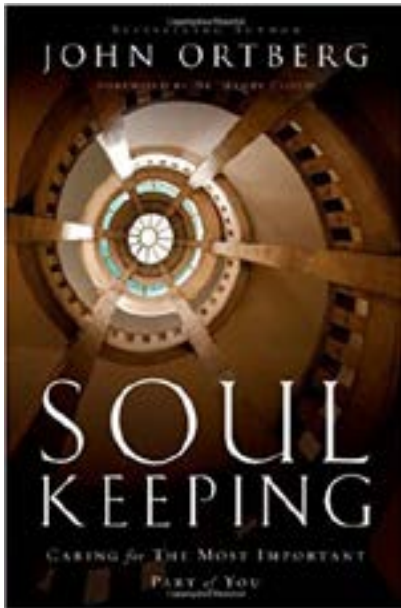

Soul Keeping



We take care of ourselves in a variety of ways—
Body: eat right, exercise, get enough sleep.
Mind: meditation, relaxation, education.
Soul: What?? What do we know about our souls?

This fall our congregation will experience a church-wide small group experience called Soul Keeping: *Caring for the Most Important Part of You*.

The series will begin September 25. Small group dates will be announced shortly. A celebration dinner at the end of the series is open to all who have participated in the experience. Save the date: Saturday, November 10 at Ozaukee Country Club.

We currently have over 100 members in ongoing small groups on a variety of topics. This Fall they have decided to turn their attention to this important study of what Jesus called more important than the world.

If you aren't already in a small group, you will be able to choose a session in which to take part, whether it is an existing or new small group or one of our two large groups,

all beginning in late September. The times offered are intended to bring together people who are at similar places in their life's journey, leading to some really engaging conversation, learning and fellowship.

In this 6 session study, bestselling author John Ortberg will help you discover your soul—What is it? What does it run on? How do we care for it?—and take your relationship with God to the next level.

The basic format of the two large group sessions will be to gather in Fellowship Hall, where there will be food and drink provided. After a bit of fellowship, we will watch a video which will help us discover the importance of caring for our souls. Then we will break into facilitated small groups to talk about what we have learned and what it might mean for day-to-day life. Each session will take no longer than 2 hours. The over 40 age group will meet on Tuesdays and the 20's-40's age group will meet on Fridays.

Our hope and prayer is that you will choose to be a part of this important small group study. Signups begin in August. Watch for more information in the days to come.

Hygiene Kits collection for Serenity Inns

Many of you already know about Serenity Inns—the transitional living facility in Milwaukee for men who are in recovery from drug and/or alcohol abuse. FPLC participates generously in many aspects of Serenity Inns' operation, including serving on the board or leadership team, providing 3 dinners each month, helping to organize the annual "Celebration" fundraiser, and working arduously to rehab and furnish the Alumni House apartments.

We have a new and easy way to participate! During the month of August, we will be collecting personal hygiene items for each man to receive when he first arrives at Serenity Inns. As most of the men arrive from prison or detox centers, they come with nothing. There are approximately 25 new men participating in the program each year, so our list will provide enough supplies to cover one year's worth of new residents.

On Sundays in August, look for a sign-up in Fellowship Hall. We will provide a list of items and will ask each person or family to provide all the items on the list—enough for one man. We'll also give you a bag to hold the items you bring back to church. Look for the bin in the Welcome Area or drop them at the church office during the week. The items will be put in more permanent bags and delivered to Serenity Inns once we have them all back.

This is a wonderful family activity and provides an opportunity to talk to your children about drugs and the danger they pose, both short-term and long-term. Thank you so much for your participation! For information, please contact Minna Smith at mokismith@aol.com or 414-852-1525.
