Construction Update!

It was another busy week at the building site. If you drive by this week, you will notice some differences on the outside of the additions, but of course, so much is going on inside too!

Cardinal Fabricating had a small crew working on the lower roof areas on either side of the sanctuary addition and stairwell framing this week.

Cornerstone Plumbing worked on the installation of the new drain tile system on the west side of the building.

Crown Carpentry delivered some equipment, as they will start metal framing this week.

Design Build Fire Protection received a large delivery of piping. They'll begin work in the office addition this week.

JC Building Systems completed the wood framing of the exterior and we are now ready for the roofers to continue working on the new shingled roof of the sanctuary.



Lyons Electric worked in the office addition and continued to core holes in walls/ floors as they extend conduit runs.

Masterfoam transformed the look of the exterior by nearly completing the spray-applied weather barrier over the new block walls. This work is extremely sensitive to the weather and we are fortunate to be as far along!

Robinson Brothers has cut out all of the remaining structural steel (the orange beams) that made up the structure of the chancel within the sanctuary. Additionally, they began saw-cutting the last section of concrete foundation wall which needed to be removed. It couldn't be demolished until the new structural steel was in place.



Dinner Fellowship with Serenity Inns Residents

They share their stories with the group while experiencing valuable social interactions which were often lost during addiction. This is a great activity to do with your middle/high

school age youth so they can hear the anti-drug/alcohol message.

Serenity Inns provides a safe home for men in Milwaukee to recover from their addiction to drugs or alcohol. FPLC volunteers provide 3 dinners a month for the residents. You can also drop off a meal or order a meal to be delivered.
