Throughout the decades FPLC has been a valuable partner to Luther Manor. In October of 1956, FPLC received a gift of \$200,000 to be used "in the care of the aged". A committee was formed and recommended the construction of a faith-based facility to serve the elderly in the Greater Milwaukee Area. That facility, Luther Manor, opened on June 5, 1961, with 12 residents. By December, 95 residents resided. We can be proud of our history, support and the growth of Luther Manor during the last 60 years. Luther Manor won the following award, Best of Senior Living 2021 Award and Luther Manor is listed among America's Best Nursing Homes 2021, according to an annual survey produced by Newsweek magazine.

The Friends membership donation support projects and programs that enrich the lives of Luther Manor residents. Your memberships will help fund the program "Cycling Without Age" that originated in Denmark and is currently in place in Wisconsin facilities like Luther Manor. The program includes purchasing 2 trishaw bikes that will be pedaled by trained volunteers. All residents will be able to ride in the trishaws. The Wisconsin Bike Federation will serve as a resource.

Serenity Inns provides a safe home for men in Milwaukee to recover from their addiction to drugs or alcohol. FPLC volunteers provide 3 dinners a month for the residents. You can also drop off a meal or order a meal to be delivered.

Are we grateful and attentive enough to take time every day to say thank you for all of God's blessings?
