
# Churchwide SOP's

#### **Communion Aides**

Every 1st and 3rd Sunday, Fox Point Church has Communion at both the 9 am and 10:30 am services. To assure that this portion of the service proceeds smoothly, we need volunteers to help with Communion setup on Saturdays (the time is up to you); and then two more people are needed to refill the trays and to help in the Sacristy during the 9am service and the 10:30 service. ## **Serenity Inns Dinner Fellowship**

Serenity Inns is a residence for men in recovery from alcohol and/or drug abuse in Milwaukee. We have a long volunteer relationship with SI.

### What to expect when volunteering?

Volunteers make dinner at home & take it warm to the Inns by 5:45 pm (for a 6 pm start time). Your family joins them for dinner and conversation. Because you'll be serving about 12-15 people, two families are welcome to volunteer together. You're usually on your way home by 7 pm. ## **MacCanon Brown Homeless Sanctuary (MBHS)**

MBHS is a daytime shelter working to provide food security and meet the community member's essential needs while connecting them to Milwaukee's resources. The organization strives to create a sense of community and care in Wisconsin's most underserved neighborhood.



#### 150 Lunches

On the 4th Sunday of every month, FPLC makes 150 bag lunches for MBHS to hand out to their guests who come to the shelter for a week's supply of food on Tuesdays.

Two ways you can help:

- Volunteer to grocery shop for the supplies needed to make the lunches.
  You will be reimbursed for the cost and provided with an exact grocery list/instructions. Sign up through the QR code or on our website. (Current slots are full. 2025 dates will be scheduled soon.)
- Join us at 10 am on the 4th Sunday of the month to make the bag lunches-it takes about 25 min. No need to sign up, just show up!
