We'll assign each student a list of food items to supply. The lists are specific so each guest gets the same items. We'll send out details as it gets closer. The kids will assemble the bags on Dec. 4 but the food will be due to FPLC at the workshop on November 20.

Some students on Dec. 4 will be Christmas elves preparing for the Christmas Open House and the Children's Christmas Eve service, “Pageant in a Bag”. There are several behind the scenes things to do!

Christmas Cookies for All Peoples Church

Please have your student bring: 1 dz Christmas cookies (homemade are preferred) to the workshop on December 4. The students will package them in festive boxes that night.
