Two 6 oz boxes or one 12-16 oz bag of Turkey Stuffing Mix

3 boxes Jiffy cornbread mix

1# elbow macaroni noodles

1# Velveeta or generic cheese; NOTE: This is found on the grocery shelves, it is NOT refrigerated

2-14.5 oz or one 27oz Glory Mixed Greens (often found at Walmart or Meijer if not elsewhere)

1 box instant mashed potatoes

12-16 oz turkey gravy

24-30 oz canned sweet potatoes

5-7 oz hot sauce

10-12 oz Uncle Bens or Rice-a-Roni rice

14 oz whole berry cranberry sauce

### Hygiene Kit Items

Hand Soap – bar or liquid

Deodorant

Lip Balm

Toothpaste 4-8 oz

Toothbrush – single

Dental Floss

Body Lotion – 2-6 oz

Band-aids

### Frozen Poultry Items

Turkey (12-14 lb), turkey breast or chicken

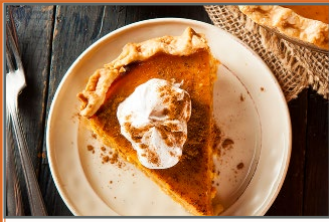
### Delivery Instructions

If you are buying a turkey, turkey breast or chicken, please put it in the freezer in the kitchen pantry and check your name on the list provided on the freezer door.

All items are due back by November 11 at 4 pm.

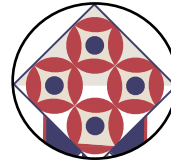

### Knitters and Crocheters Needed!

#### Soap Sacks

Soap Sacks are hand-knit or crocheted drawstring bags that hold a standard size bar of soap. The sacks can be used simply to hold the soap or people can leave the soap in the bag and use it as a soap-filled wash cloth. FPLC will fill each bag with a donated bar of soap and deliver them to our partners in Milwaukee to give to their pantry guests. Some of the guests are homeless or move frequently. They may not have access to soap or washcloths on a regular basis.

If you wish to include soap with the Soap Sacks you donate, please keep the soap in its wrapper before putting it inside the sack. That way it stays clean until it reaches its recipient. Donations can be left in our food donation carts.

See the links below for instructions. If you have a pattern you'd prefer to use, that's fine! We just ask that they be similar in size, have a drawstring or tie to close the sack and that you use cotton yarn.

*"He says, "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth." Psalm 46:10*

Accidentally clicking on the Microsoft app, Copilot, found me in unknown computer territory. Ideas and words popped up so quickly that my eyes couldn't keep up – I was overwhelmed! As a first venture in unleashing the power of AI, I found that Copilot operated at warp speed. Then I found two small information boxes: one read "Stop Responding" and the other read "Ask Me Anything." It reminded me of Our Father's words – asking for a little quiet yet offering us the grace and love of good conversation. Copilot was starting to redeem itself!
